
ClimACT Code - Instructions

The ClimACT Code aims to encourage participation and creativity of the students involved with ClimACT project by producing a communication work: the poster. The student should be able to identify a set of attitudes and behaviours conducive to improvement of the environment at school, home and the community. The ClimACT Code should express a statement of objectives, translated by concrete actions, which all community members must follow, thus constituting the low carbon code of conduct of the school. The option of presenting the ClimACT Code in the form of poster aims to facilitate communication and dissemination of the principles that each school undertakes.

Should be a collective work, where the involvement and participation of students is important. The Low Carbon Coordinator is responsible for the preparation of the code in each school. The ClimACT Code should be discussed by the Low Carbon Committee. Please, send the poster (pictures or video) and also the descriptive by e-mail to climact@abae.pt. Entries must be sent by June 22, 2018 to the e-mail address indicated. Works that do not meet the requirements will not be accepted for the contest. The decision of the Jury can't be appealed. This contest is open to every ClimACT Schools (Portugal, Spain, France, Gibraltar) and there are 2 categories: 1st Category: students between 6 and 14 years old; 2nd Category: more than 14 years old.

The ClimACT Code must comply with the following requirements:

- 1. In cardboard 65x50cm or A2;
- 2. Vertical orientation;
- 3. Be completely two-dimensional are not allowed works with collages of objects that make it impossible to frame the poster;
- 4. Hold approximately 10 to 12 sentences about school's commitment to sustainability;
- 5. Approach to various topics: water, waste, energy, transports, citizenship, sustainability, etc;
- 6. Composition of all graphical elements including ClimACT and Interreg Sudoe logos;
- 7. Identification, only on the back, of all authors (school, LC coordinator and students);
- 8. The poster should be accompanied by a brief description explaining the way it was done the work maximum one A4 page.
